Europe 2020 follows the Lisbon Strategy. Europe 2020 is the strategy for the current decade proposed by the European Commission on 3 March 2010 for advancement of the economy of the European Union. It puts forward three priorities:

- Smart growth- developing an economy based on knowledge and innovation,
- **Sustainable growth** promoting a more resource efficient, greener and more competitive economy,
- Inclusive growth- fostering a high-employment economy delivering social and territorial cohesion.

The strategy has set five ambitious goals in the areas of employment, innovation, education, poverty reduction and climate/energy. These EU-level targets have been translated into national targets in each EU country, reflecting different situations and circumstances, and they are currently measured by ten headline indicators. EU and national targets are available in the data tables.
