[Europe 2020](#) follows the Lisbon Strategy. Europe 2020 is the strategy for the current decade proposed by the European Commission on 3 March 2010 for advancement of the economy of the European Union. It puts forward three priorities:

- **Smart growth**- developing an economy based on knowledge and innovation,
- **Sustainable growth**- promoting a more resource efficient, greener and more competitive economy,
- **Inclusive growth**- fostering a high-employment economy delivering social and territorial cohesion.

The strategy has set [five ambitious goals](#) in the areas of employment, innovation, education, poverty reduction and climate/energy. These EU-level targets have been translated into national targets in each EU country, reflecting different situations and circumstances, and they are currently measured by [ten headline indicators](#). EU and national targets are available in the data tables.
