

Register identifier and legal persons, entrepreneurs and public authorities (RPO)

From 1 November 2015, the Register and identifier of legal entities, entrepreneurs and public authorities (RPO) has become a legal data source in accordance with the relevant legislation. It is a uniform data source of all legal entities (legal persons, entrepreneurs, public authorities) which are currently registered or recorded in more than 70 source registers and registrations through various types of information systems.

RPO was established in accordance with the National Concept of Informatization of Public Administration and it is part of the e-Government. The register will contain data from all source registers within 2 years after the entry into force of the Act on RPO, i.e. November 2017. All the existing source registers of legal entities will be integrated by that date. Data for the legal entities registered in the registries administered by the Ministry of Justice and the Ministry of the Interior, will be entered into the RPO, within 3 months after the entry into force of the Act on RPO, i.e. by no later than 1 February next year. However, the RPO will provide data from the business register and the registers of the Ministry of the Interior (trade register, register of political parties and political movements, non-profit organizations etc) as at 1 November 2015.

Electronic services provision

Services intended for citizens and entrepreneurs also include extract from the RPO or the electronic depreciation from the RPO for public authorities. The services will be provided by means of the Central portal of public administration www.slovensko.sk or the portal of the SO SR <https://rpo.statistics.sk/rpo>. Another functionality of the RPO is an online allocation of the identification of companies in the process of formation of all types of legal entities, entrepreneurs and public authorities.

License agreement for the use of the data from the RLE

1. SO SR as an administrator of the RLE applies the Creative Commons Attribution 4.0 International Public License - cc by 4.0 (hereinafter referred to as the Public License) to the use of data made accessible from the RLE, according to Section 7, Article 2 of the Act No 272/2015 Coll. on the register of legal entities, entrepreneurs and public authorities and on amending and supplementing certain acts (hereinafter referred to as Act on RLE).
2. The scope of the public license covers the data made accessible via the website of the SO SR, under the Section 7, Article 2 of the Act on RLE.
3. SO SR gives consent to the use of the subject of public license and to the exercise of the license rights ("license") under the public license cited above.
