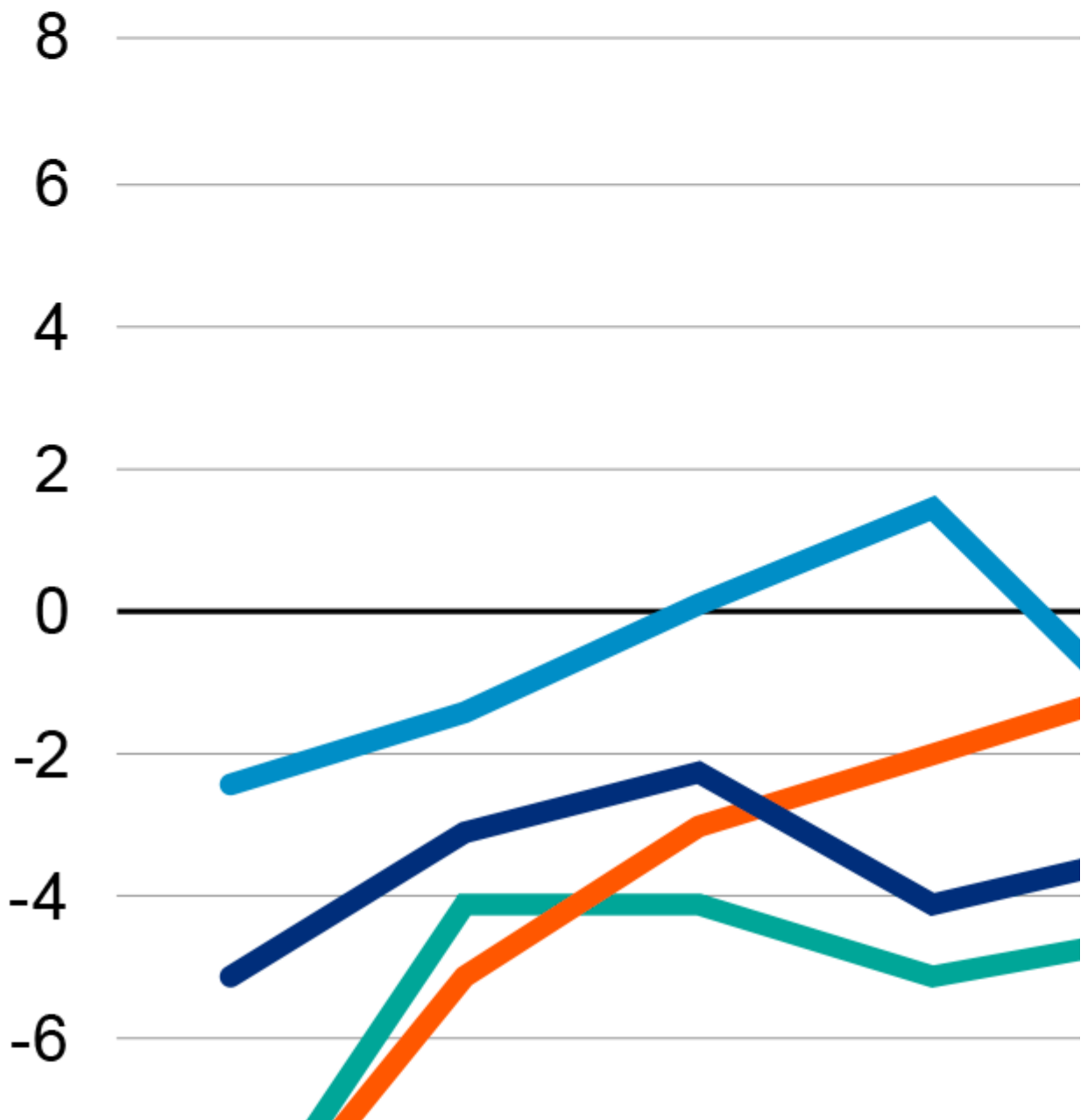
Real wages increased in most sectors in 2023, but a decline in employment did not stop

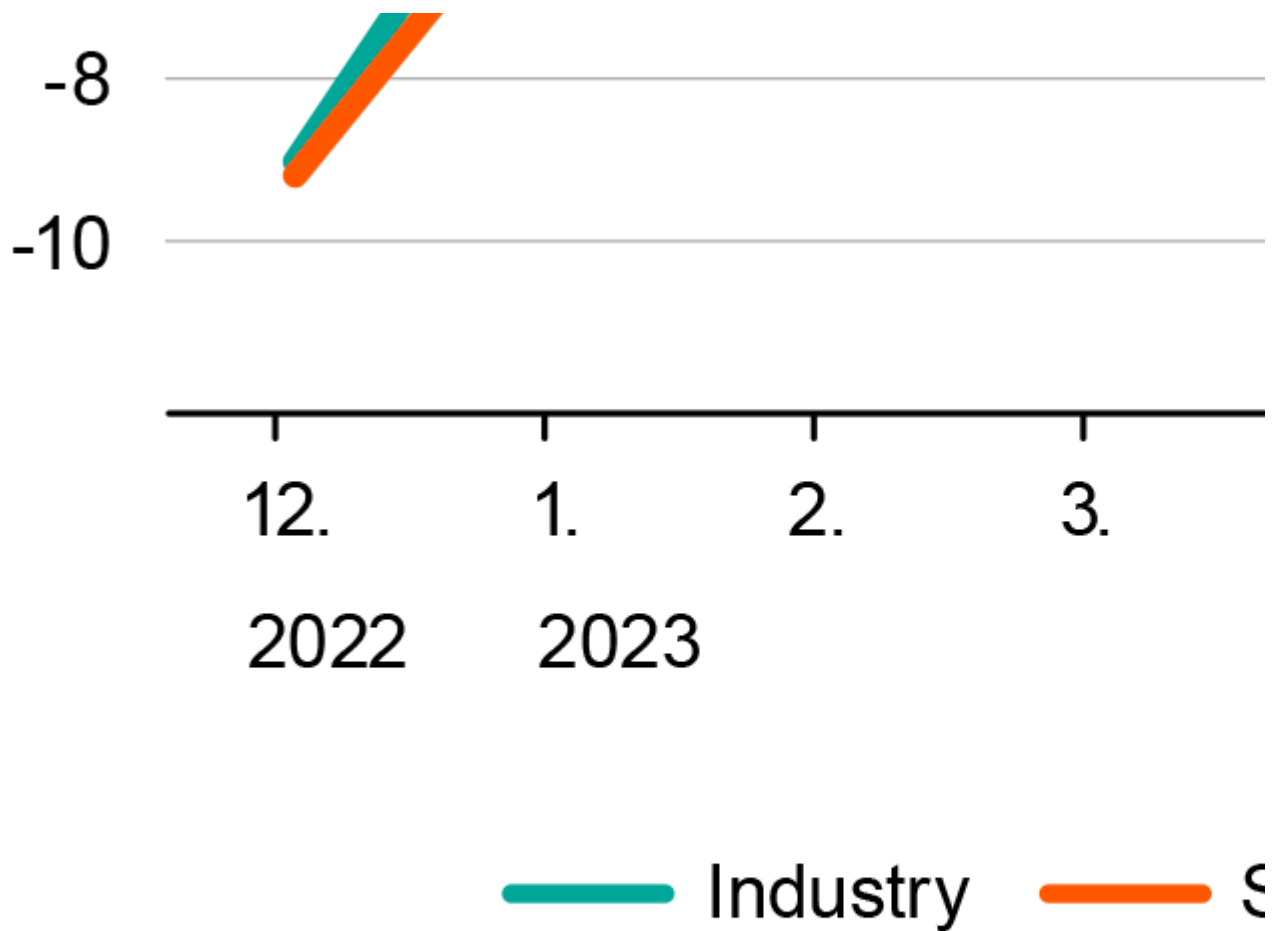
In 2023, the average wage increased year-on-year in all ten monitored sectors, in seven of them even at a double-digit rate. Wage growth was faster than inflation increase in six sectors. A decrease in employment was recorded in most sectors, in industry the number of employees decreased for the fifth consecutive year.

The average nominal monthly wage¹⁾ increased year-on-year in all monitored sectors, with double-digit growth in only half of them in December. The most significant growth was recorded in food and beverage service activities by 15.1% (EUR 724), the lowest in construction (EUR 1,064) and also transportation and storage²⁾ (EUR 1,415), both by 7%. **The real wages** of employees in all monitored sectors were also higher year-on-year in December 2023. Their growth ranged from 1% in transportation and storage to 8.7% in food and beverage service activities.
