**Term** Current residence of the inhabitant

**Area of use** Population and Housing Census

---

**Definition** Place where a person usually spends daily rest, regardless of temporary absence for recreation, holidays, visits to friends and relatives, business, medical treatment or religious pilgrimage. Persons who have their usual residence in a specific geographical area are only considered to be persons who:

1. have lived in their place of usual residence for a continuous period of at least 12 months before the reference time, or
2. arrived at their place of usual residence during the 12 months before the reference period with a view to staying for at least one year.

If the circumstances referred to in point 1. or 2. cannot be determined, usual residence may be understood as the place of lawful or registered residence.
