**Term** Compensations for income upon temporary incapacity

**Area of use** Labour, Labour costs

**Definition** An employee is entitled for compensations for income upon temporary incapacity to work if an employee was found incapable to work due to illness or accident or was in quarantine and he/she is not entitled to receive wage, salary or bonuses. Compensations for income upon temporary incapacity to work are provided from the first to the last day of temporary incapacity from work, but no longer then ten days of temporary incapacity (since 2026 not longer then fourteen days).
