WHAT IS CENSUS

- The Census is a **comprehensive statistical survey**; realized in the SR every 10 years by the traditional method i. e. self-enumeration method.
- Contents, scope and method of conducting the 2011 Population and Housing Census was established by **the Act No. 263/2008 Coll. on the Population and Housing Census in 2011**.
- **Census Period** was identified by the government of the SR by its regulation; the Census was conducted **from May 13th to June 6th 2011**.
- **Point in Time Relevant to Census** was **midnight between Friday, the 20th of May 2011, and Saturday, the 21st of May 2011**.
- **Census Results** provide the view on society state, its demographic, social, cultural, educational and economic structure as well as information describing the housing standard and the structure of the existing housing stock. **Results are basis for forecasting the development in various areas from the highest territorial level to the municipal level.**

SOME TOP FACTS FROM THE 2011 POPULATION AND HOUSING CENSUS

- The 2011 Population and Housing Census with using several new approaches marked the history as **the most advanced** statistical survey of its kind in Slovakia. Residents were allowed, for the first time in history, to choose whether to fill out the Census Sheets in paper or electronic form by the Internet.
- The 2011 Population and Housing Census was by content **the most extensive** survey on population. The legal law imposed the duty to participate in the Census on all citizens of the Slovak Republic and foreigners residing in the territory of the Slovak Republic in the point in time relevant to census (except for foreigners who enjoyed diplomatic privileges and immunities).
- Census 2011 was one of **the most important** statistical surveys of its kind internationally. According to Regulation (EC) of the European Parliament and of the Council it counted for the first time in history in the same year (2011) inhabitants, houses and dwellings in all EU Member Countries, using uniform or comparable definitions of surveyed data. Census 2011 was part of a global program of population and housing censuses, coordinated by the UN in collaboration with Eurostat.

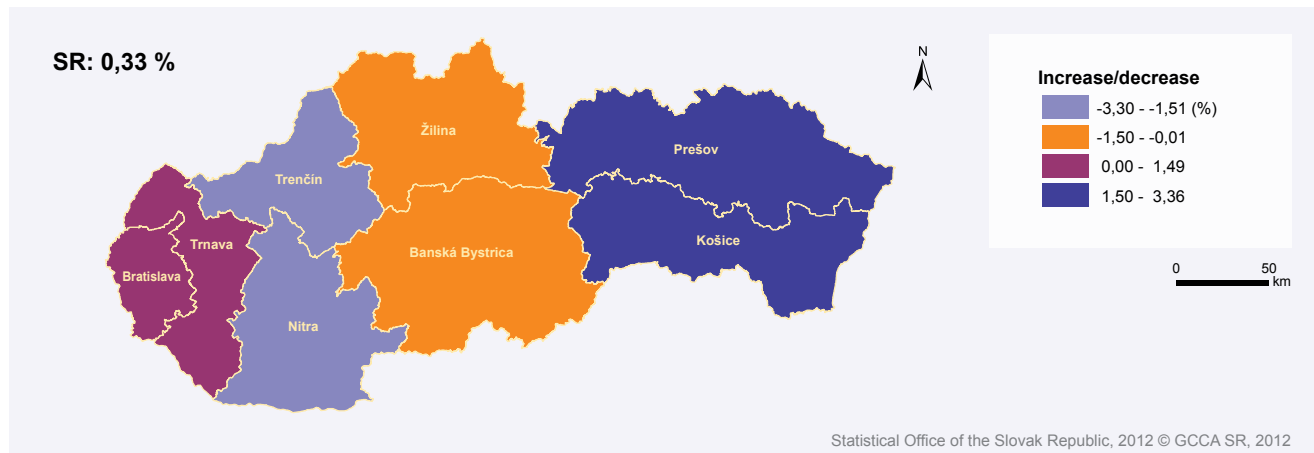

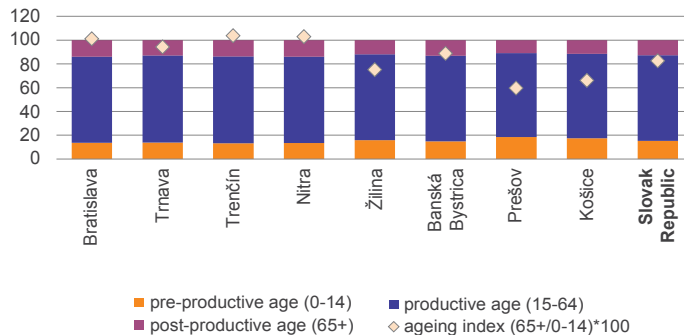
M 1 Change in the number of permanent resident population in regions of the SR in the intercensal period 2001 – 2011



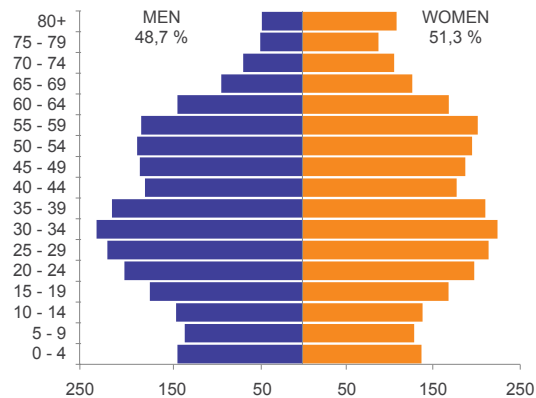

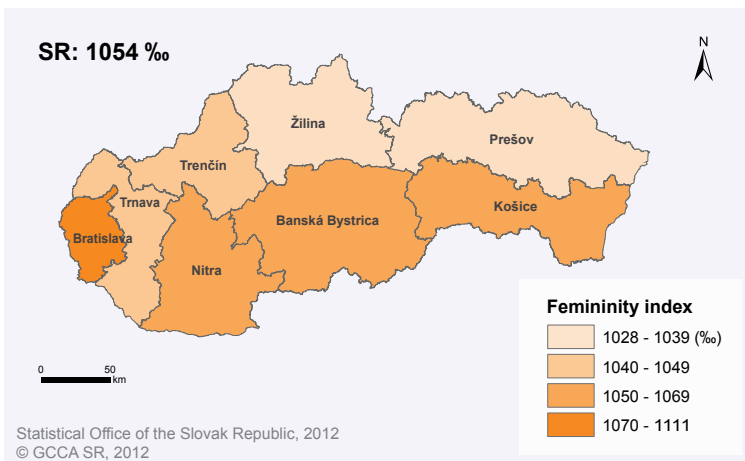
G 1 Permanent resident population in the SR and regions by age groups in % and ageing index, SODB 2011



G 2 Permanent resident population in the SR by 5 years age groups in thousands, SODB 2011



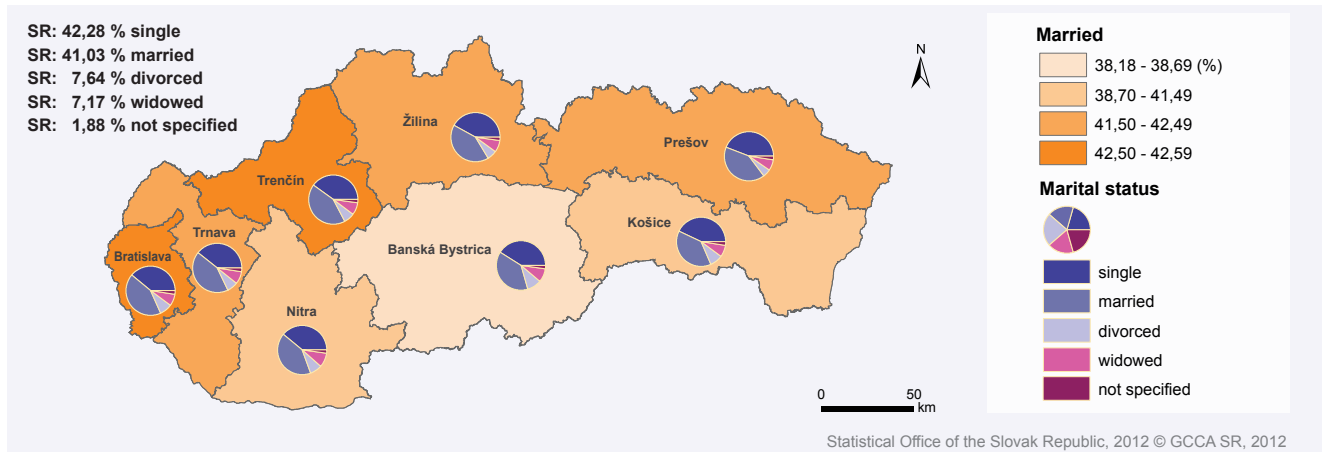
M 2 Femininity index (the number of women per 1 000 men) in regions of the SR, SODB 2011



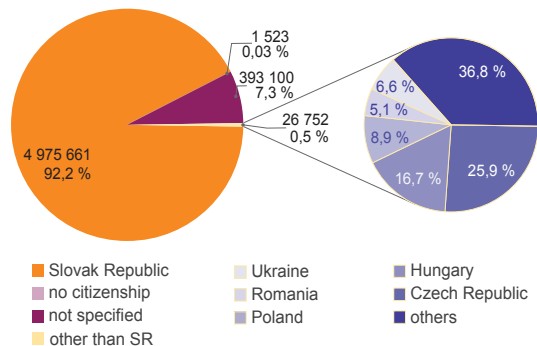

M 3 Permanent resident population in regions of the SR by marital status, SODB 2011



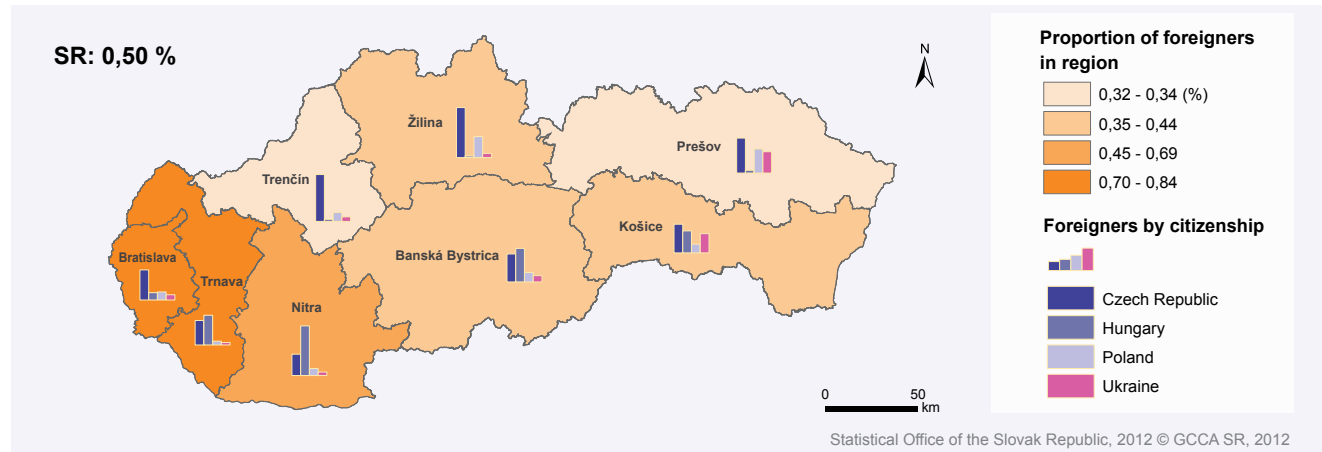
G 3 Permanent resident population in the SR by citizenship, SODB 2011



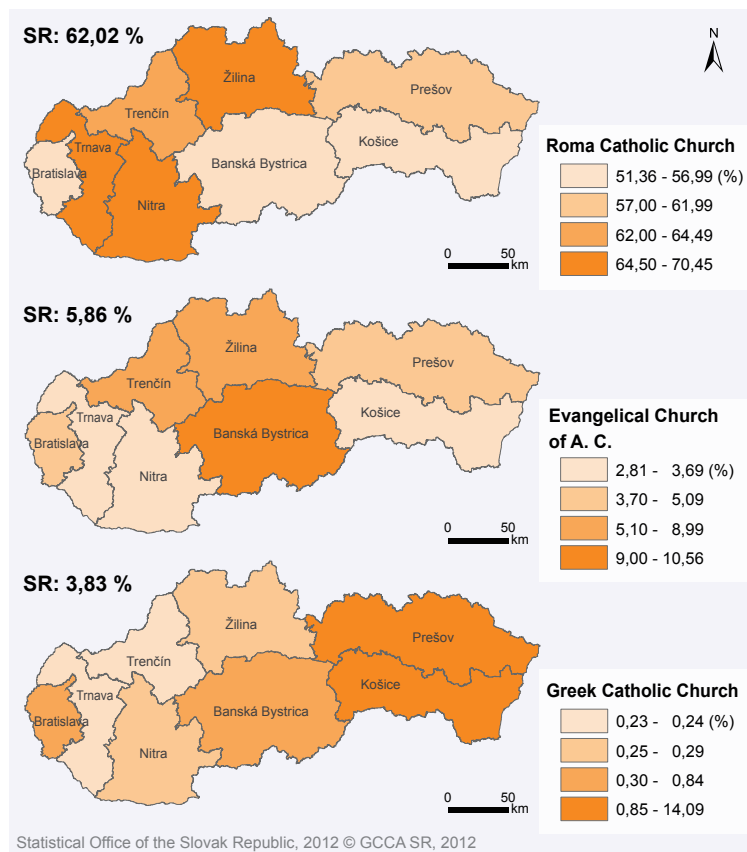

M 4 Permanent resident population in regions of the SR by other citizenship than SR, SODB 2011



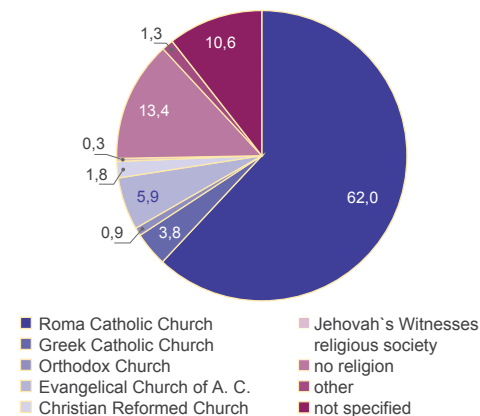

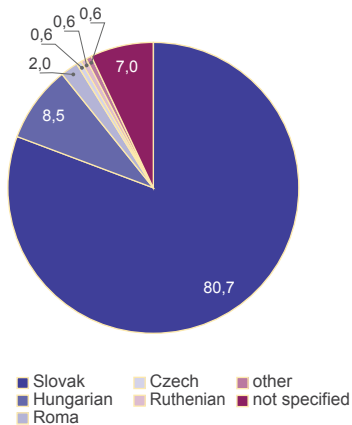
G 4 Permanent resident population in the SR by religion in %, SODB 2011



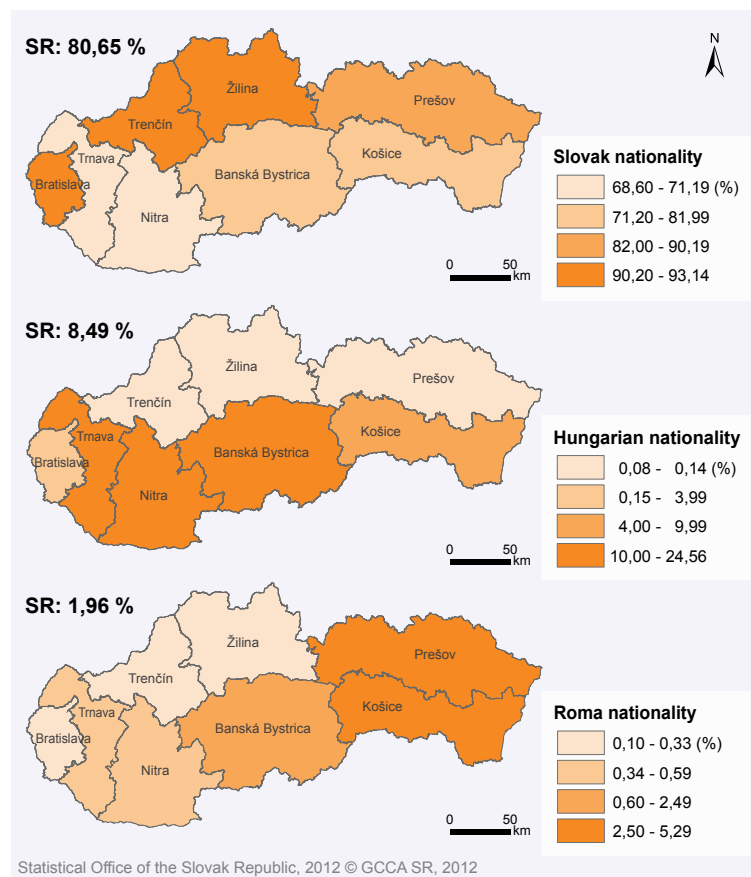

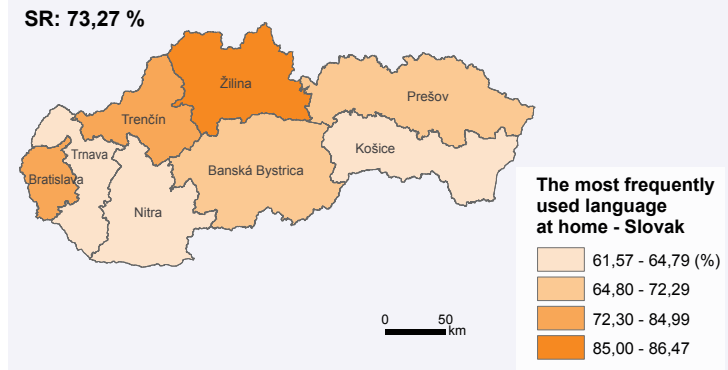
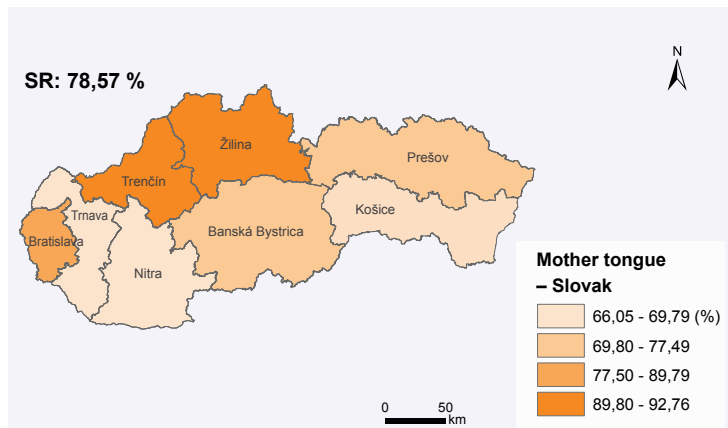
G 5 Permanent resident population in the SR by nationality in %, SODB 2011

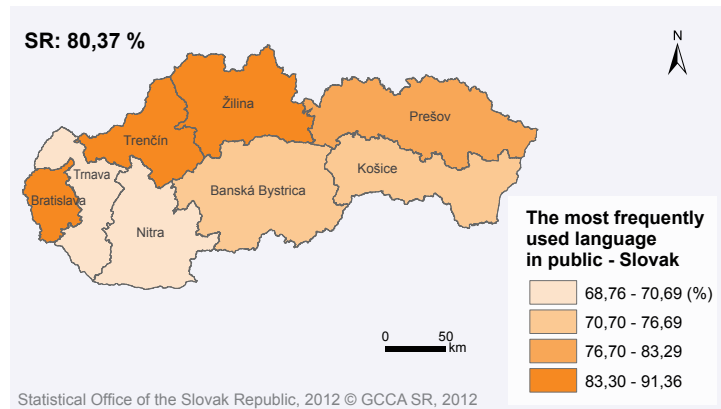

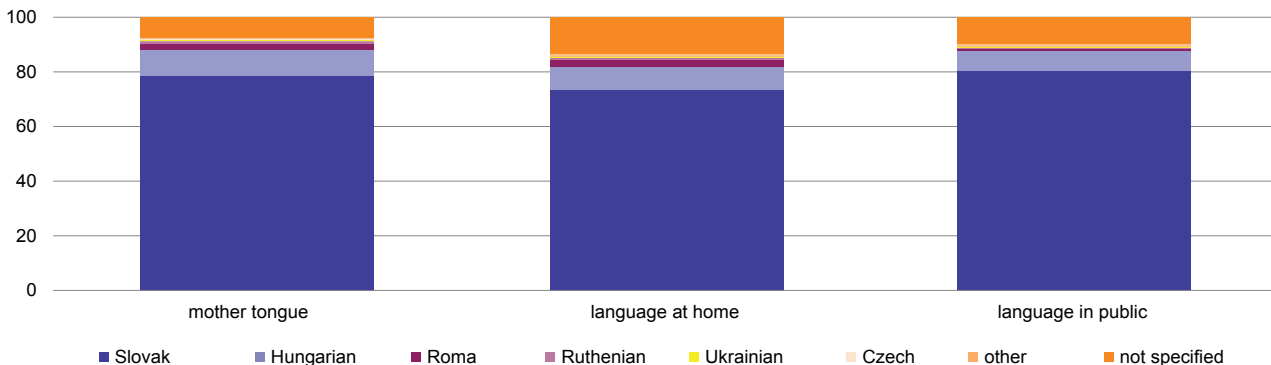

M 8 Permanent resident population in regions of the SR by the most frequently used language in public, SODB 2011



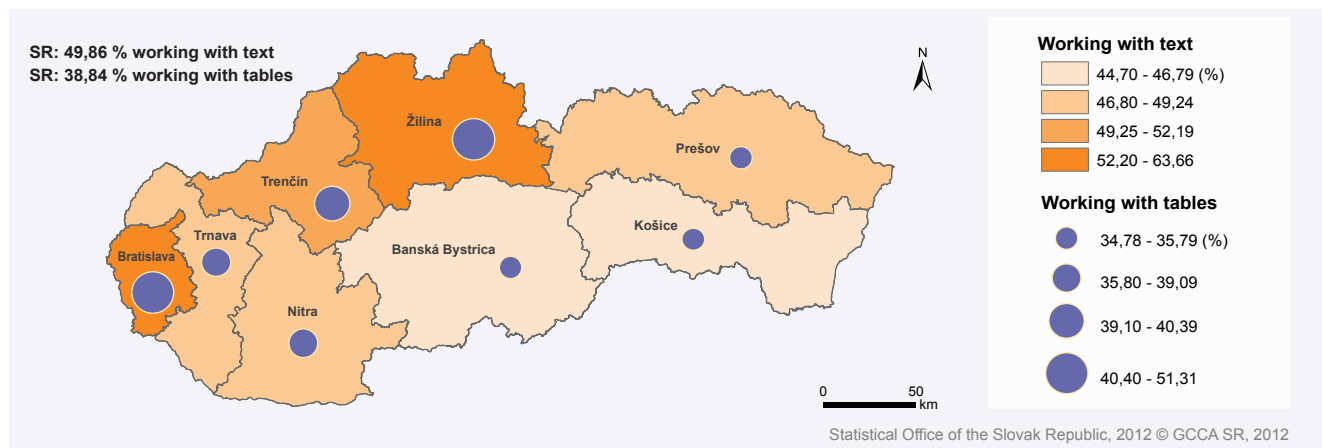
G 6 Permanent resident population in the SR by mother tongue, the most frequently used languages at home and in public in %, SODB 2011

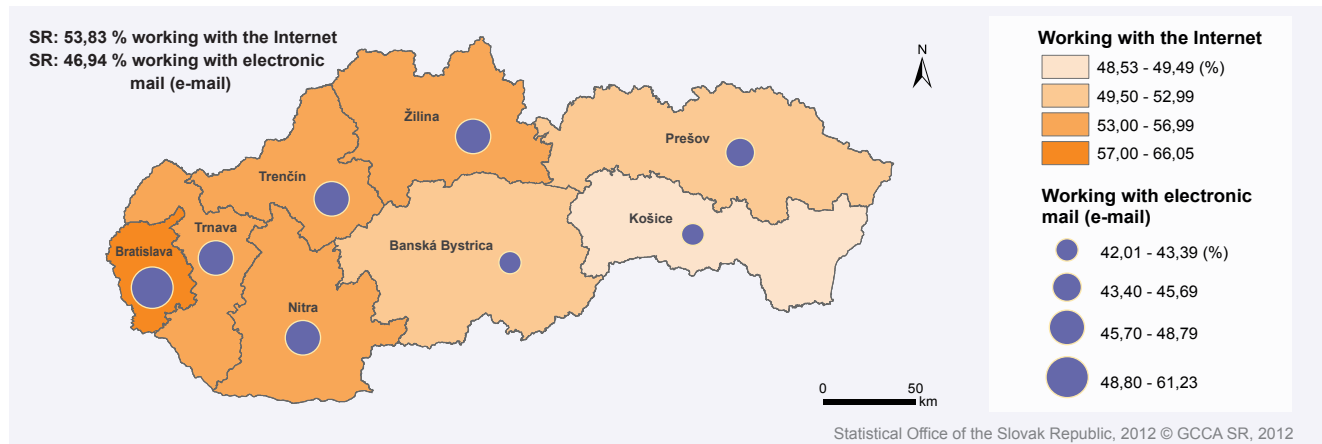
M 9 Permanent resident population in regions of the SR being able to work with text and work with tables, SODB 2011

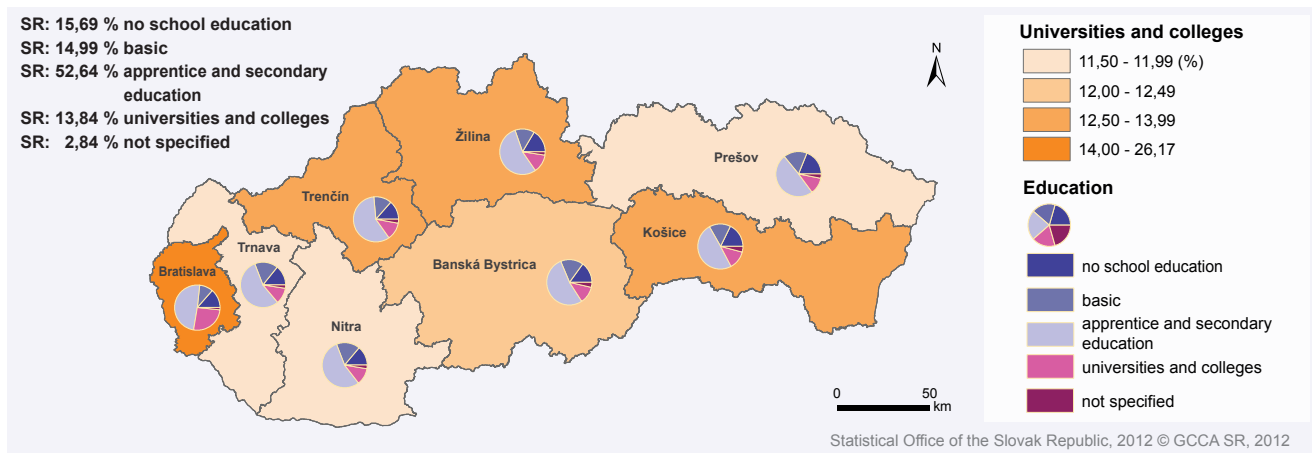
M 10 Permanent resident population in regions of the SR being able to work with the Internet and electronic mail, SODB 2011
